Prez Sez

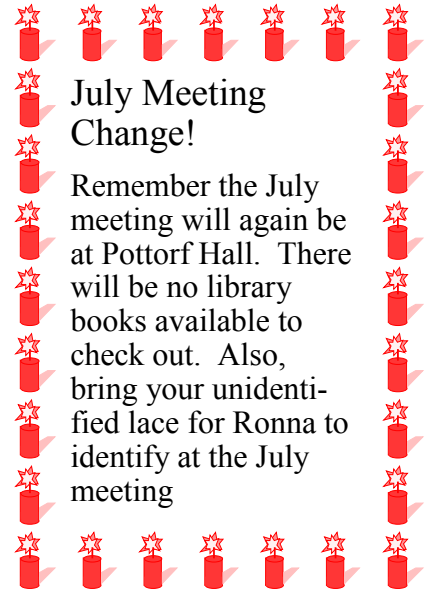
I hope everyone enjoyed the June program as much as I did.
