



President's Quilt Block for Ronna: Known by many names, Ronna found this Kansas Dugout block and would like it done in red and white with a blue center. Cut one block of blue fabric & four blocks of white fabric,  $3\frac{1}{2} \times 3\frac{1}{2}$ ". Then cut two blocks each of red and white fabric,  $4\frac{1}{2} \times 4\frac{1}{2}$ ". With a red and white placed face to face, stitch  $\frac{1}{4}$ " on each side of the diagonal & cut on the diagonal to create 2 corner blocks. Repeat for the other 2 corner blocks. Press to the dark fabric. Trim to  $3\frac{1}{2} \times 3\frac{1}{2}$ ". Join the blocks as shown to be  $9\frac{1}{2} \times 9\frac{1}{2}$ " to finish to  $9 \times 9$ ". Please be sure to sign your block.
