

October Designing and Piecing Wearable Art Theresa Bennett

Learn how to draw and design your own wearable art. Learn how to piece your design and quilt it. We will only work on one of the front pieces of your garment in class.

Supply list

freezer paper

pencil (I like mechanical pencils)

fabric marking pencils or chalk for both light and dark fabric

masking tape

long ruler, and optional - flexible curve ruler or circle templates if you have them

scissors for paper and fabric

commercial pattern for vest or jacket. Keep it simple, no darts or princess seams. Set in sleeves best.

sewing machine and your extra sewing feet, such as walking foot, free motion and embroidery foot

basic sewing supplies

variety of fabric pieces of various sizes you would like to have in your garment

bating, Thermore is best for garments because it is very thin

quilting safety pins to sandwich the garment layers

light weight muslin or batiste to layer under the batting for quilting

you will need lining for your garment after the garment pieces are quilted, will not need during class
